

What You Need to Know About

the RMLS[™] SentriLock Conversion

... if you use your Supra Key in more than one MLS

Some RMLS[™] subscribers have their Supra keys programmed to access lockboxes for Willamette Valley MLS, Northwest MLS, or other regional MLS providers in addition to RMLS[™]. Due to our upcoming switch to SentriLock, RMLS[™] will no longer be able to cooperate keys with these organizations.

What does that mean for you?

Find the statement that best fits your situation below for details.

I use an ActiveKey obtained through RMLS[™]:

- Bring your ActiveKey and any RMLS[™] iBoxes you own to a conversion event.
- At the conversion you will receive one SentriLock lockbox per RMLS[™] iBox returned (all boxes must be registered to you), as well as a new SentriCard[®] and card readers.
- You will need to obtain a new Supra key through the other MLS if you wish to continue accessing listings that use their lockboxes.

I use eKey software on my phone and obtained my key through RMLS[™]:

- Bring any RMLS[™] iBoxes you own to a conversion event.
- At the conversion you will receive one SentriLock lockbox per RMLS[™] iBox returned (all boxes must be registered to you), as well as a new SentriCard[®] and card readers.
- You will need to obtain a new Supra Key serial number, or ActiveKey/DisplayKey through the other MLS if you wish to continue accessing listings that use their lockboxes.

I use a Supra key (any type) and obtained my key through another MLS:

- Bring any RMLS[™] iBoxes you own to a conversion event.
- At the conversion you will receive one SentriLock lockbox per RMLS[™] iBox returned (all boxes must be registered to you), as well as a new SentriCard[®] and card readers. If you want to convert your RMLS[™] Supra iBoxes to work with your other MLS instead of exchanging for SentriLock boxes, you will need to bring them in to an RMLS[™] office to be deprogrammed.
- You may also elect to receive a new SentriCard[®], if you wish to continue accessing RMLS[™] lockboxes. There will be no activation fee for a SentriCard[®] if you pick it up at a conversion event or arrange an alternate conversion at an RMLS[™] office by January 10, 2014.
- You will need to keep your Supra Key for access to lockboxes in your other MLS system.

Give the new SentriLock system a try!

For keys issued by RMLS[™], we will apply a \$22 credit for SentriLock key fees to your bill issued December 1, 2013, if you have converted by November 27th. If you have a Supra key issued by another MLS, you will *not be charged for trying the SentriLock system* until the first quarter of 2014.
